I hatched out a batch of Texas A&M quail, and at the age of five weeks, put them in the coop with their parents.

I came out later to find only two of them alive, (barely) and the rest torn to shreds.

The surviving chicks are now 8 weeks old, and I'd like to put them back in with their parents.

With chickens its best to leave them until they are "adult" --- aka 18 weeks
What is the equivalent age in quail --- use that :~)
Basically if they don't act as adults --- keep them separate
