The Above Image, is of a human gyroscope, similar to the 6 degrees of freedom biomechanics laboratory they have at Wright Patterson. The program that is part of the Air Force Research Laboratory is called the human effectiveness directive. The experiments they do over there is what inspired Stephen Jay Gould to create a new theory of evolution, called punctuated equilibrium. The theory states that during times of total crisis, biological life will adapt at accelerated paces. So when animals are put into an equilibrium, evolution makes punctuated leaps. That's exactly what they are doing at Wright Patterson, with their Human Gyroscopes.

They have one that works something like what's in the photo, but it is used to study biomechanics & how the body holds up in extreme conditions. They are trying to find a way to change the human genetic structure and make-up outside of test tubes. Some UFO buffs think gyroscopes are anti gravity machines. On big old navy ships they would use them to balance the ships at sea, and in submarines too. At wright patterson airforce base I think they are studying how these gyroscopes effect human development, and of course they are inside of aircraft for navigation systems.

You can read about the "human effectiveness directive" if you google it, but all the websites say they will put you in jail for reading them with unauthorized access.
