seems a normal thing when one remarks that typing "Proto-Ionians" on Google or Yahoo, there are c. 1,000 references.

Actually, Google only gives 676 reerences, rather less than 1000,

Go to the last page and you will see that it only are 92 references. The rest is "very similar to the 92 already displayed"
But searching GoogleGroups gives 1070 hits. I suppose all Grapheus

And did you made the same search for the WIKI-articles LAUNCHED by Henrik ?... Do it !.. and you will get numbers about ten times smaller...

But Henrik is a "Wiki-administrator", right ?... And so works WIKIPEDIA : AS A SECTARIAN GROUP.
