If the weather is clear tomorrow evening I plan to try and watch the Moon occult the Pleiades. I'll be using a 90mm refractor, and am wondering which size eyepiece would be better, my 25mm or 40mm? I suspect the latter for the wider FOV, but I am not sure.

Yes, probably the 40mm would give a nicer view. But just use/try them both and use the one you enjoy the most.
