I am interested in observing some of the many Hamburg Quasar Survey cataclysmic variables for which no AAVSO chart (or any other, as best as I can tell) has been created. Is there some place on the internet where I can create such charts? I would need a limiting magnitude down to about 15.0 or so.

The recent outburst of HS2331+3905 (=V455 Andromedae) to 8th magnitude suggests that monitoring of these objects might be rewarding, but the lack of available comparison star charts is surprising, and a real hindrance!
