Facing northwest, which way would I pan my binoculars from Algol to m34; from Eta in Perseus to the Double Cluster?

Assuming mid-northern latitudes, M34 is about 5 degrees to the lower right of Algol around midnight. The Double Cluster is similarly about 4 to 5 degrees to the lower right of eta Per.
