4. Siderite as a Component of an Ancient Stromatolite

"Mossbauer spectra at two temperatures of a freshly slabbed portion of a 2.09 Ga (Early Proterozoic) hematic chert stromatolite from the Gunflint Iron Formation

The sample investigated was freshly slabbed for the Mossbauer transmission measurement, so the iron carbonate is interior to the native stromatolite rock."
