My supplier has only offered me paper with the plastic backing, which I don't want.
The collective power of the internet should be able to find it, right?

Since the trend (certainly in chemistry labs here) is away from using open benches to "all work in fume cupboards", I would guess that the need for such an item has severely diminished. I suspect your supplier has offered you "Benchcote", which is what we would typically use in a QC lab, on the titration benches. What I have used in the past is filter paper (big ones 24" x 24" square!)
