I'm preparing a board design to send to a PCB vendor. I've never done this before. I was told I need to supply them with the footprint for each part. Now, some parts that I have come in packages like TQFP, which I know are not standard, so I found a detailed drawing of the particular package. But what about packages like TO-263 for a voltage regulator? Are all packages not standard, should I supply drawings for every part? What about capacitors? I don't know a footprint (or even part number) for them, I just need small surface mount caps. Any advice would be appreciated.
