Depends – if you are drawing schematics that will eventually become PC boards, then you do want an electronic CAD package, as such packages will make sure that your board layout matches the schematic.

If you are just doing general documentation of wiring harnesses or system cable connections, a mechanical drafting program is OK – you can just ignore all the spurious stuff like dimensioning, 3D views, etc.
