> the only one like it I have. Google turns up nothing searching for
RS536 &
> Op Amp. Just searching for RS536 only returns "about 202" hits.
There's a
> listing under www.usbid.com which indicates that it is a known device
of
> some kind but there's no other information there. That is the *only*
> electronics-related hit in the list.*

toss it.*
