>Haven't done this since the 2764 days, but you need to make sure you

>don't have any floating address lines. If there's an extra address pin,

>you can tie it high, low or to the next lowest address pin, depending on

>which is easier in your circuit. Program it in the same configuration.

Remember to duplicate the data over the two halves of the chip,
