>One solution you might consider would be to (temporarily or not) uninstall
>NAV, and install another virus checker such as Grisoft's AVG (which happens
>to be both excellent and free for home use). Or run one of the various
>online virus checkers. That'll help give you some confidence that your
>problems don't stem from being currently infected.

A sound suggestion, thanks, that's the way I'm beginning to think. I have now revisited the Symantec site and re-installed LU, so I'll see what if any effect that has. But, as I may have mentioned before, I'm becoming increasingly disenchanted with Symantec so may switch. AVG sounds attractive, as one of problems with NAV is the pressure at subscription renewal time.
