> *Why doesn't Windows suspend to disk? Just copy all of ram to disk and*
> **fully* shut down, zero power. Restart would take about 2 seconds;*
> *spin up the disk, restore RAM, run.*

My copy of Windows (Windows 2000 Server) has a suspend to disk feature. It doesn't work on my motherboard – probably something to do with the quad processors or the dual hotswap power supplies – but it's there.
