- > *I would like to know if it is possible to encode a MP3 file into SBC.*
- > *I want to stream a MP3 file between a PocketPc and a PC over Bluetooth*
- > *using A2DP profiles.*

Well, you might have to decode the mp3 to raw pcm first, but then it's no problem. You can get an open source SBC codec from <http://bluetooth-alsa.sourceforge.net/> and then do the mp3->pcm->sbc transcoding via
mpg123 --au - file.mp3 | sbc/sbcenc - > file.sbc
