Or did you mean pictures of the gizmos themselves? Some items (try Network Analyzers) show pics, click on others and get a pdf with pics.

I have webwasher, which identifies my browser as "Whatever by whoever 1.2.3.4". Disabling that gives me a "please enable cookies", even though cookies are enabled.
