Currently, they are used to generate high voltage for ion air purifiers (ozone), that are supposed to make the air safer to breathe. Interestingly enough, these products aren't sold by reputable sellers and they all come in plain boxes with no mention of the point of origin. So, getting information about how they operate is easier said than done:>
