the data would be table of char and number only , they are colour, not  
black and white.

I would really appreciate simple solution for this, perhaps single chip  
solution.

There's an example of an old- fashioned 'tennis' type video game (c. 1972  
vintage) in the Texas MSP430 examples. It shouldn't take too much to  
tweak that to output characters from a LUT instead of moving 'bats' and  
'balls', with RGB outputs for the colour.
