NT4 on this PC (rarely ever freezes), Win2k on the office machine (freezes on occasion), XP in the lab (freezes a lot). Somehow I see the trend going in the wrong direction here.

I had to wrestle with the sales folks a little to get my office computer with Win2k and not XP. Had to pay an extra \$100 or so but in hindsight I am glad I spent that money. The lab computer couldn't be delivered with 2k anymore since some of its HW would be incompatible, they said.
