I have found Samwha's product to be very reliable in high volume production.

I wonder if esr and other such parameters mean much in your high-volume application? I had a few Samwha caps in my drawers, and was surprised at how poorly they did. But then they may have been quite old.

I wasn't using the Samwhas in a low ESR application, just their plain vanilla parts.
