Charlie,

You may have the same problem I had when I went to Verizon FIOS. There is a problem with a DNS somewhere. It intermittently (most of the time) returns a TCPIP address for news.verizon.net that does not work. My workaround was to update my HOSTS file with a good TCPIP address:

C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM32\DRIVERS\ETC\HOSTS

One line had to be added as the last line in the file:

199.45.49.11 news.verizon.net

Don't know if that will help you, but it's worth a look.
