How strange, but maybe not. Suse 10.0 and 10.1 were a bit flaky. Try 10.3, it is real nice IME. Handles my A64-X2 dual core nicely and is very clean. Radeon X2600 and 22 inch 19:10 flat panel as well. 10/100/1000 Ethernet, high d 7.2 sound on MOBO. Getting XP running was ten times the hassle, mostly over sound.

I tried Suse for a couple of months. It was hellish. If I ever give Linux another go it will probably be with Ubuntu.

As I indicated a while back, I found Ubuntu to be totally unusable (i/e uninstalleable). The display was unreadable (~.001pt fonts).
