I hope here in the news some one who passed the same problem (or a similar one) will give me a good advice. I appreciate your answers anyway, thanks once more.

I think the projector has been already serviced once, because of some "non original" components on the drivere board and maybe for the same problem, because if I put my finger over one of them (so making a sort of "ground") the problem decrease!

If I disconnect the "red" lcd and then reconnect it (while the unit is on) the problem disappear and comes back (and stays) if I touch with my finger (same as above) in the driver area.

Challenging, isn't it?
