Hi

This is not going to be easy without being able to post the picture, but here it is: my brand old (but awesome) NAD 7240PE blew up spectacularly the other day – with smoke and all..

If you open the case, you will see 2 big capacitors (80v6800uF, the biggest of them). Just beside these, towards the front of the device, there are 2 smaller capacitors (35v330uF). Now, just in front of those 2 capacitors are lined up 2 resistors (color code brown black red gold), 2 diodes, 2 more resistors (same color code) and one resistor ... ??? Well mine is completely black. CAN SOMEBODY TELL ME THIS RESISTOR COLOR CODE PLEASE?
