It might be a bit more complicated if your monitor is fed by more than one BNC cable.

If the video and sync are separate (or R-G-B and sync), you may experience some difficulty finding a hardware interface solution.

I haven't done what you're suggesting, but I've noticed separate V & S output connectors on Barco source input switchers (to projector) units that I have.
