NWS has some excellent data on their website, including fire warning data, however their long term temperature records are non on line.

For a starting location, I've selected the NWS facility at North Platte, NE, but I'm assuming that their records may not extend back as far and I need. I'm emailing North Platte to ask what information they can provide, hoping that this will provide me with a start. I've selected Nebraska because of its location almost the center of the US and far removed from localized coastal weather effects, although any location in mid-America will suffice for my purposes.

I'll eventually need data from Europe, Africa, South America, etc., but I suspect that long term data from these locations will be far harder to obtain because I first need to learn the appropriate agencies to contact.
