Personally, I'd look at either the Garmin 60CS or 76CS, the latter having more memory, and of course costing more ;-)

You wouldn't get all the maps for Europe in either, you'd need to upload the maps you require from a PC as and when you need them, but the 76CS does have higher capacity (115 MB, 60CS 56MB).
