My iPAQ is a rx3715. In the topo application it does not list my device... it only lists; Lowrance, Garmin, Magellan and NMEA. That's the other thing, I can't test my GPS unit from the PC topo application, it only gives me options for com1 and com2, and my pda cradle connects via USB.

i will defer on the pc topo question, because i am not familiar with the program. to connect the bluetooth gps with your desktop pc, you will not use your pda. you need a bluetooth enabled desktop, and that will connect wirelessly with the gps. the easiest way to add bluetooth to your desktop is to buy a usb bluetooth adapter - they sell for about \$20 on ebay. you will plug it in to a usb port on your desktop (or laptop), it will flash blue just like your pda does, and the bluetooth software will most likely find your gps by itself.
