> the route?

Yes.

> I also notice on the GPS unit itself, that it has an option to set  
> recalculation to off or on. Should I turn that option off, so that it  
> does not make these new decisions for me?

Leave it on. It should auto-recalc to the "next" waypoint in your route list if you go off course (and as this is only a partial route recalculation, it should happen pretty quickly, too).
