> wanted to change from street and highway mapping to topo mapping on the
> fly, you might need to have access to a computer to upload the new mapping.

Not necessarily. Garmin units that accept their map products allow you to load maps from different types of map products simultaneously. You can have street maps and topo maps loaded, and switch between them on the unit. You are of course limited to the max memory of the unit, which could be more of a limitation if you want to load multiple map products. You might need access to a computer for *that* reason, but not to switch map types.
