For me the advantage of the compass is that your map on csx model will rotate with your movement and always will point in direction you are facing regardless if you are moving or not. This is very important in thick bush where you cant move fast.

Good point, hadn't considered that aspect, map rotation ! Do you know if the compass always take priority or does the GPS kick in above a certain speed ?
