Even worse, once you have bought MapSource and registered it to the first unit, that unit is always the unit for which one unlock is used every time you upgrade. Even if you don't even own that GPS any more, it still takes one of your two unlocks each time you pay for an upgrade, and there is apparently no way around this.

I'm getting all teary-eyed reading this. :P

This is why, when you sell a GPS unit, you sell the maps with it.

Before you get all hot-under-the-collar (or is it too late?) be sure to check out the liensing policies of equivalent units that license and use NavTeq maps. You'll find the grass isn't really greener anywhere else.
