With Beta 2.71, the track logs get saved with the day in the name. That means the largest track log on the micro SD card the unit will save is 24 hours of track. If the unit is running past midnight local time, it creates a new file with the new date and keeps on ticking. With this caveat, there doesn't seem to be a limit except the size of the micro SD card you have.

Can you see the track log files on the SD card from Windows Explorer? Or only with MapSource? I guess the files are not anything as simple as ASCII text files.

When you get it back to the PC, MapSource does become a problem. I have a 7 Meg track which took 17 hours to gather. It takes MapSource over 15 minutes to open this track on my 2GHz laptop. During that time, MapSource is taking 100% of the CPU. The MapSource data parser needs some real work! Once the track is in MapSource it seems to handle it just fine.
