

Re: Need help with GPS track 3D in Google Earth

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"New Learner" wrote:

For some reason I can't get the line thickness above 4 but I'm working on it.

Don't work too hard; as far as I know, it can't be done.

Thanks, that's good to know. I thought it was something on my end. On my monitor 1600x1200 resolution, the flight line looks pencil thin. Would be nice if I could make it nice and fat.

Check the graphics settings in Google Earth's preferences; if lines are truly pencil-thin, you may need to switch from DirectX to OpenGL or vice versa.

....and shortly thereafter, "allory" wrote:

If you open the .kml file in a text editor there will be a section near the beginning which reads:

<Style id="lineStyle">  
<LineStyle>  
<color>64eeee17</color>  
<width>4</width>  
</LineStyle>  
</Style>
```

Change the width value to a larger number and save the file.

Unfortunately, this is only true in Google Earth 4 and above. If you're using GE3, 4 is the maximum recognized width for track lines.
