Keep in mind that the 60Cx does not include the detailed street maps, a big enough memory card, or a car mount. These options will add quite a bit to the price. You shouldn't need to buy anything extra for the Quests. Not sure about the Magellan.

Yes, this is a significant issue. I'm currently trying to get a better handle on total costs including maps and necessary accessories.

Do folks have any specific recommendations for maps to be used with the 60CSx/76CSx? More specifically:

- * Which particular street series?
- * DVD versus microSD card?

The DVD seems like it should offer the most flexibility but I'm wondering if licensing and copy protection hassles make that a pain in the ass.

Garmin sure have done a lousy job of describing what you get with each of their maps and which maps work with which devices.
