The "Search" and "Market" modules – which are also free of charge – integrate all of these items as selection criteria.

The quality of the services provided is guaranteed by the network's admission criteria and controls: each candidate is approved by the Intranet Regional Administrator for the applicant's country of origin, the linguists admitted must have more than 3 years' professional
