ÀsÆµÅ³± = Serb. pobegao fled; povukao se stepped back), Lat. fuga (flight, fleeing, escape); paveo (frightned) Lit. bk gstu, bk gau, bk gti intr. (frighten; cfr. Czech uprchnout, Serb. prhnuti ran away; Alb. frikë fear, Ger. Furcht, Eng. fright); bauginti (frighten), baugus (fearfully); Russ. 8A?C30==K9 (ispuganiy) frightened ?C30BL (pugatL frighten; Slav. \*be go( in Russ. be gu (Inf. be ~a tL), Little Russian. bihu (run), as OCS. neologisms pribe gno(, pribe gno(ti etc. (to flee), also OCS. be ~o(, be~ati (to flee), etc; Ir. búal water& Serb. bojati se (be afraid), bojiti (paint), bujati (overflow; bujica torrent).

Obviously, running away and fearing are the most closely related notions.
