What the consequences might be for western civilization is not yet clear, nevertheless there is a real danger of intercultural conflict and loss of some valuable identity factors.

There is a point in your post I find plainly wrong: prices won't probably rise as a consequence of immigration; massive immigration provides corporations with cheap labor force and this diminishes costs and prices. The threat is here for native workers who are now obliged to compete with an increasing supply of labor force. The social and welfare state in Europe is also threatened by immigration, while European capitalists enjoy a new golden era due to massive immigration. As a European worker I cannot be indifferent to this.
