David, MTN is a fine newsreader for OS X.

That may very well be – I know nothing about MTN.

But saying it's a fine newsreader seems inconsistent with Virgil's statement "MT\_Newswatcher does not display the entire thread, nor allow easy access to it".

It does not automatically display an entire thread, and while access to it is possible, it is not trivial.

As one normally does not need an entire thread, but only the last post, the other advantages of MTN outweigh that minor disadvantage.

That does seem a severe limitation to me. I very often use Agent to browse back through a thread, often even when I have already read all the messages in it.
