I've put together an open source app, plot2d (<http://plot2d.sourceforge.net>), for plotting data (from ASCII files, almost any delimiter) directly to a compressed image. It uses a simple ASCII options file. It can also generate statistics for each series.

The project is still in the Alpha development stage. I'm looking for further design feedback on the software.
