>>> astrology reading or a religious blessing for a goat or a chicken
>>> to eat. But look how these two have grown! Both astrology*

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- > > > **and* religion are really "rakin' it in" these days, aren't they!*

- > > *Christ teaches that one can not serve two masters.*
- >
- > *As read in the corrupted Bible, Andrew.*

Christ continues to teach this to me in my walk with Him.

- > *If a man lies to you, how easy is it to believe him in the future?*

Easy when I have refrained from judging him.

- > *There are many*
- > *gods as set forth by God in the Ten Commandments.*

The choice to either accept or reject God is set forth in the "ten commandments."

Idols and graven images are not gods though you may choose to believe they are.

- > > > *What matters is that God's teachings*
- > > > *have been and still are being interpreted differently by different*
- > > > *human groups.*

- > > *Actually, Christ teachings are written so plainly that there is*
- > > *remarkably very little differences in interpretation.*

Correct. Would suggest you open your eyes.

>

> > *There are no risks associated with accepting Christ, who has defeated*

> > *both satan and death. You are citing imaginary risks that satan would*

> > *conjure up for you.*

>

> *Of course there are risks, as i've cited previously.*

What you cite are imaginary.

> *And i didn't need*

> *Satan to conjure them up for me.*

Nonetheless satan did.

> *All i needed was the realization that*

> *there is a whole big world out there filled with many different kinds of*

> *beliefs, faiths, religions.*

There are attempts at either controlling or rejecting the one true God.

> *There is no way Christianity is the right one.*

>

Your judgment.

Christ is **the** way, **the** truth, and **the** life.

There is no other way to explain what you have witnessed here.

>

> > > *For you to blindly accept this as Truth just shows that you have*

> > > *not really studied your material well enough.*

> >

> > *It is what I discern.*

> >

> > > *You cite the risking*

> > > *of nothing if one accepts Christ, but what about the risk you take*

> > > *if Christianity turns out to be a Devil's faith, while the Sikh's were*

> > > *right all along?*

> >

> > *Christ has defeated the devil. For this reason, if you choose to*
> > *reject Christ, then you have chosen to accept satan as your lord.*

> *How convenient. This must be what gives people the right to*
> *kill each other.*
>

No. This is what compels Christians to follow the two commandments of Jesus Christ:

(1) Love your heavenly Father with all of your heart, all of your soul, all of your mind, and all of your strength.

(2) Love your neighbor as you would love yourself.

> > > *What if that islander soul out on the Pacific who*
> > > *daily worships a huge boulder at the east end of his island turns*
> > > *out to be correct? Rocks harboring the spirits of God's angels is*
> > > *no more difficult to accept than the concept of some old guy in*
> > > *the sky who pulls all the strings to line the pockets of a few well–*
> > > *chosen priests and pastors.*

> > > *Forgive me, Andrew. I guess i'm still a little pissed about what*
> > > *the Christian Church did to Galileo and to Bruno before him...*
> > >

> > > *I'm also a bit miffed about how Christianity is misused by people*
> > > *everywhere. And the situation seems to get worse instead of*
> > > *better almost every single day! So, while i *do* believe in God,*
> > > *and while i *do* study the written words of most religions in*
> > > *order to learn more about God, i shun religion totally, especially*
> > > *the Christian religion. And this probably because i was brought*
> > > *up as a Christian, and i feel that Christianity let me down. More*
> > > *importantly, Christianity has let the world down. Big time.*

> > *Your judgment.*
>
> *It is what i "discern".*
>

Discernment is *not* judgment.

>
> > > *But then so has *every* religion due to the corruptions of God's*
> > > *words. And the only thing that really sticks in my craw, the only*
> > > *little piece of evidence that God may NOT exist, is the fact that*
> > > *this situation has been worsening for a long, long time, and God*
> > > *seems to be totally complacent about it. This bothers me to no*

> > > *end. God, if he or she exists, just doesn't appear to care about*
> > > *us, or about this planet we live on.*
> >
> > *And so you judge God.*
>
> *Yes, i judge God. It is as he appeared to want things. He did*
> *not make us puppets or machines. He gave us the ability to decide,*
> *to "discern", to judge.*
>

You have the gift of free will and so you may choose to judge others. However, it does not appear that you have God's gift of truth discernment. With His gift, you are able to discern as the blind are able to see.

> > > *So why should *we* care?*
> >
> > *This is a choice you will have to make out of your own free will.*

> *You missed the point, Andrew. Why should we care if God*
> *doesn't appear to care?*

It remains your choice to decide whether or not to obey God (see Jesus's commandments above). I have chosen to obey Him simply because I love Him with all my heart, soul, mind and strength :-)

Apples and oranges.

> > > *You will never convince those*
> > > *of us who've studied the matter to any depth that Christianity is*
> > > *the one true and correct religion.*

> > *Again, God's purpose for me here is to inform you of the logical*
> > *aspects of the decision you will be making.*
>

> *Then why do your words sound so... illogical?*

>

Though I have God's gift of truth discernment, I do not have His gift of mind–reading.

>

> > > *I'm pretty well convinced that*

> > > *it's not.*

> >

> > *Again, your decision will now be an informed one.*

>

> *It has been an informed one for some time, now, Andrew. Nothing*

> *you have said is new to me.*

>

In truth, what I have written here is new to you (i.e. you have not ever read it before).

>

> > > *If God speaks through Christianity, then why isn't EVERYBODY*

> > > *flocking to it?*

> >

> > *The same reason that most everybody did not believe they would perish*

> > *in the Great Flood of Noah's time. Without God's help, few are able*

> > *to discern the truth on their own (myself included).*

> > > *Why are some Christians murdering doctors?*

> >

> > *It would be my choice to refrain from judging others.*

> > > *Why*

> > > *do some Christians kill other Christians of all ages with bombs and*

> > > *bullets?*

> >

> > *See above.*

> >

> > > *Why do some Christian *priests* like to have sex with*

> > > *little boys?... and so on, and so on.*

> > *See above.*

> >

> > > *Let's face it, Andrew, religion sucks! Especially that religion*

> > > *known as Christianity.*

> > *Your judgment.*

> > > *While having many things to answer for, God is still probably the*

> > > *best thing to ever happen to this Universe.*

> > *It remains my choice to refrain from judging others especially God.*
