My Treo "polls" my home e-mail every 15 minutes to check for new e-mails. I also downloaded Pocket Tunes deluxe and use it for Shoutcast-Internet radio.

The hardest thing I've run into is finding a stereo headphone jack. I guess I'll have to order from PalmOne...it should have come with the phone!

Still finding new things every day, but the performance of this phone has been superb.

The Treo 600 is set up to "poll" the RSS-FEED from your doctor's office that runs through DentalCom.Net.

There are no additional charges as it pulls the same information from both feeds simultaneously.
