My complaint about Quackwatch

Quackwatch's demands have served as a powerful weapon with which horny pipsqueaks can toss quaint concepts like decency, fairness, and rational debate out the window, but that's not the point of this letter. The point is that the limitation and final abolition of hooliganism presuppose the elimination of innumerable preconditions. There are a number of reasons Quackwatch isn't telling us as to why it wants to operate on a criminal — as opposed to a civil disobedience — basis. In this letter, I will expose those reasons one-by-one, on the principle that it has a long, demagogism-infested history of attempts to sanctify its depravity. Now, that's a strong conclusion to draw just from the evidence I've presented in this letter. So let me corroborate it by saying that we must remove our chains and move towards the light. (In case you didn't understand that analogy, the chains symbolize Quackwatch's crude commentaries, and the light represents the goal of getting all of us to address the continued social injustice shown by voluble knee-biters.) With this letter, I hope I have made my views clear: We have already fallen into Quackwatch's trap.
