this technic

1 conventionaly tray- large enough to allow for plenty of material buccaly and labialy. extension deep enough in posterior region to properly cover tuberosity

2 ordinary compound snap impression is taken

3 after the tray has been removed from the mouth and chilled, cut away 1-2mm of compound from center of hard palate to ridge, over entire labial wall to periphery. Trim periphery clear of muscle interference

4 mix plastogum and apply on tray over entire surface

4 place tray into mouth

5 1 minutes for functional impression
