I have reviewed the posts of the last few weeks. Most of the questions are good questions and show frustration on the part of patients. Three of us wrote a book, a consumer's guide to dentistry. It is available on Amazon.com, search for "Open Wider." Two of the authors are patients who had dentists suggest 8 crowns each that they did not need. (Actually one needed one crown.)

The book would answer most of the questions you have asked. I have has over 1400 messages criticizing the book on two dental town sites and another dental list. Dentists do not seem to like the book; although, very few dentists have read it.
