>> unpasteurized, or raw, milk from the Dee Creek Farm were
>> asked to contact their health department, whether they were
>> sick or not."

>> and again...and again, because irresponsible people
>> with seemingly good intentions continuously lull trusting
>> consumers into doing the wrong thing.
