> > > *Once again, dear Andrew, you are confusing truth with fact.

> > *For those who can discern the truth, there is no confusing the truth
> > with anything.

> *And what, pray tell, gives you the ability to discern truth?*******

Indeed it is written in Ephesians 2:

10For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
