**ABOUT JOURNAL:**

JPS aims to train students for peer-review publication processes. Due to its nature, publication procedures of the journal are not very restrictive. For example, a PhD student with a related publication can be a reviewer for a manuscript. This not means JPS publish unscientific articles. This means originality of a manuscript can be lower than other journals. On the contrary, JPS uses blind peer-review and double-blind peer-review processes to ensure the quality of publications. With this structure, JPS will be a best choice for publishing unpublished posters, BSc projects with interesting results, experiments with standart results or publications that need quick and open access.
