I have written the article and want to publish it. I work in the area of high energy QCD. I see that there are many journals, which have appropriate research area. How to choose the journal for publication?

If you have to ask, it's probably not worth the trouble. Scientific research is communicated via journals. You should be familiar with the journals in your field, and thus know which would be appropriate. If you are not familiar with them, how do you know that your results have not been obtained by someone else?

If the article will be rejected, is it good practice to resubmit it into another journal?

It depends on the reason for the rejection.
