(It served in Rescue, Photo-Mapping, and Weather Recon roles, as well as as a Utility Transport and Pilotless Aircraft. (AS in both a target and as an air-sampler for A-and H-Bomb tests. The B-24 was dropped like a hot potato, and was pretty much gone by 1948.
